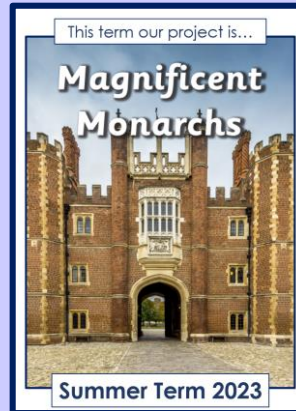
Art/DT
