## Year 2 Topic Homework Activities - Traditional Tales

This term Year 2s topic is called '**A Walk in the Woods**' and is based around **Traditional Tales**. In Year 2 we are learning the story '**The Town Mouse and the Country Mouse**' in addition to many other traditional tales.

- ✓ Have fun!

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


1. Ask someone older than you about stories they remember from when they were little, write about their story (you can draw a story map if you'd prefer).

Remember to include a question mark at the end of each question!




3. With help from an adult, use the internet to research about traditional tales from around the world.
