Dear Parents, Carers and Friends,



For Harvest this year we will be collecting donations for two local charity projects, Fresh Hope and the Trinity Church King's Table project. Fresh Hope collect food such as tinned and packet goods which they offer families through a local Pantry scheme. If you are able to donate any of the items listed below it would be a great help and enable them to continue supporting families -

Tins of tomatoes, vegetables, fruit, tuna, meatballs, soup, baked beans, spaghetti, cold meat. Also teabags, coffee, sugar, pasta sauces, biscuits and crackers.

The King's Table works to offer care to those with particular need, difficulty or vulnerability in our community.

The King's Table project have said that "ring-pull" tinned foods would be really helpful to support their work.

There will be a <u>collection box on the playground on Monday</u>, <u>Tuesday</u>, <u>Wednesday and Thursday morning next week for your donations</u> which will be taken to Trinity Church, ready for the Harvest Service on Thursday October 17th at 2pm at Trinity Church. All are welcome to come along.
