

Home-School Agreement for Parents

At Holy Trinity, we believe that a strong partnership between home and school is essential for every child's development and achievement. This agreement sets out how we will work together to support your child's learning, wellbeing, and progress.

As a Parent/Carer, I will:

Uniform

- Ensure my child wears the correct school uniform every day, including appropriate footwear. This also includes PE Kit. A copy of the school's uniform policy can be found on the school website.
- Label all clothing and belongings clearly with my child's name.
- Support the school's expectations around appearance and presentation.

Homework

- Read regularly with my child and engage with school reading initiatives.
- Encourage and support my child to complete homework on time.
- Provide a quiet space and regular routine for homework.

Communication

- Check and respond to school communications (emails, newsletters, messages).
- Attend parent meetings and school events where possible.
- Inform the school promptly of any concerns, absences, or changes in circumstances (e.g. a change in address/phone number).
- Work respectfully and constructively with school staff to support my child.

Attendance and Punctuality

- Ensure my child attends school every day unless unwell or otherwise authorised.
- Avoid taking holidays during term time.
- Ensure my child arrives at school on time, ready to learn.
- Inform the school promptly of any absence and provide reasons.

Behaviour and Conduct

- Support the school's distinctive Christian ethos, vision and values.
- Support the school's behaviour policy and reinforce expectations at home.
- Encourage my child to treat others with respect and kindness.
- Work with the school to address any concerns constructively, using appropriate channels.
- Promote positive attitudes towards learning and school life.
- Act as a role model of our school values: Love, Courage and Wisdom

- Provide a safe, inclusive, and stimulating learning environment.
- Deliver high-quality teaching and a broad, balanced curriculum.
- Set appropriate homework and provide feedback to support learning.
- Communicate regularly with parents about progress, events, and school life.
- Monitor attendance and punctuality and work with families to address concerns.
- Be approachable, respectful, and responsive to parental concerns.
- Promote a culture of respect, responsibility, and safety.
